

After July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2009, camping fees are non-refundable. Any refund before July 10<sup>th</sup> is subject to a 15% reprocessing fee.

### Camping Procedures and Information

Campgrounds open: Thursday, July 16<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am.

Campgrounds close: Monday, July 20<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am.

Please clean your camping area and place all garbage in trash containers.

**\*\*\*\*Early arrivals will NOT be allowed! You will be asked to leave and not return until Thursday at 10:00 am. \*\*\*\***

#### At the check in gate:

**1. Bring this receipt with you. This is your confirmation for your campsite.**

**2. One vehicle permit will be issued and must be displayed on your vehicle's mirror.** Additional vehicles must be parked in the overflow lot near Memory Lake, next to the Laundromat or at the Fairgrounds. There is only one sleeping unit and one vehicle allowed per camp site. Drive slowly through the campgrounds and keep vehicle movement to a minimum. All campgrounds will be monitored by security and police-patrolled. We will not take responsibility for lost or stolen items.

**3. All campers need to purchase a 3-day wristband at the gate and securely attach it to their wrist.**

The 3-day wristband covers all days of racing and admission to Friday and Saturday night street dances.

Adult 3-day pass (ages 16 and over) ..... \$20

Youth 3-day pass or One day (ages 10-15).....\$12

Children ages 9 & under .....Free

**4. At ML, PS, and R check-in gates:** camper's vehicles and sleeping units will be subject to an inspection by security personnel. Any beer and/or alcohol that is found will be confiscated. If a camper refuses inspection/confiscation of alcohol or if security personnel determines it necessary, the camper will need to camp in the Fairgrounds campground. No refunds will be given. You will be allowed to have your beer and/or alcohol at the Fairgrounds campsites. Budweiser, Michelob, and Miller beverages and wine coolers, will be sold by the case from the refrigerated trucks on Olson Drive for ML, PS, and R campgrounds. Free campsite delivery will be available for large purchases.

### Rules

**Pets are not allowed** in the campgrounds or at spectator areas except for seeing-eye dogs for the sight-impaired.

**No fireworks, firearms, assault items, bicycles, scooters, ATVs, or remote-controlled toys will be allowed.** Please do not play loud music at your campsite. Security has the right to remove any item that they deem offensive to neighboring campers or spectators.

**Umbrellas or shelters are not allowed** due to spectator space limitations. There are no refunds in case of inclement weather.

**ID's will be checked and underage drinking of beer/alcohol will be enforced by the Police.** Please use common sense and enjoy our event without disrupting others. We reserve the right to evict anyone who does not comply with the rules.

**Fairgrounds campers: carry-on coolers with beer/alcohol/soda are not allowed in the spectator event area.** Empty coolers may be brought to the spectator event area. Formula/milk for infants or young children will be allowed.

### Campfires

The WI DNR has stated **no one is allowed to bring fire wood across state lines** due to diseased trees in the surrounding states. *No kidding!*

**Campfires are only allowed in elevated campfire rings with enclosed bottoms.**

Campfire wood: \$3.00 per bundle or \$5.00 for 2 bundles.

Elevated campfire rings: \$10.00 for the weekend rental. You don't even have to clean it—just leave it.

Failure to use an elevated campfire ring will result in a \$20.00 sod-replacement fee.

All campfires will be subject to weather conditions and DNR approval.

## **Campground Locations**

- 1. Fairgrounds camping (FG)** - check in: ¼ mile south of stop light intersection of Highway 70 and Highway 48-87 (approximately 8 blocks from the event). Shuttle bus schedule: Friday: 12:00 am to 2:00 am, Saturday: 7:00 am to 2:00 am, Sunday: 7:00 am until the end of the races; making trips about every 30 minutes. Quiet time at 1:00 am; Family area is at 10:00 pm. Shower facilities are in the bathrooms.
- 2. Memory Lake camping (ML)** – check in gate: Olson Drive and Russell Street. Camping is on Memory Lake in downtown Grantsburg. Quiet time at 1:00 am. Shower facilities in bath house.
- 3. Park Street camping (PS)** – check in gate: W. Jackson Street and North Park Street. Camping is located adjacent to Memory Lake on the north side. Quiet time at 1:00 am. Shower facilities in ML bath house.
- 4. Racers' camping (R)** – check in gate: W. Jackson Street and North Park Street. Camping is located adjacent to Memory Lake on the west side. Quiet time at 1:00 am. Shower facilities in ML bath house.
