

Campgrounds

Campgrounds next to Memory Lake in downtown Grantsburg:

Park Street Campground (PS): 20 non-electric RV, Motor home, or camper sites on the north side of Memory Lake (\$105). Quiet time is at 1:00 am. Shower facilities in the ML bath house & porta-potties near by. Check-in gate is at West Jackson Street and North Park Street.

Racer's Campground (R): 45 non-electric tent sites on the west side of Memory Lake (\$65 and \$95-river sites). Quiet time is at 1:00 am. Shower facilities in the ML bath house & porta-potties near by. Check-in gate is at West Jackson Street and North Park Street.

Memory Lake (ML): 38 full hook-up RV, Motor home or camper sites (\$125) and 62 tent sites (\$95) on the south west side Memory Lake. Shower in the bath house & porta-potties near by. Quiet time is at 1:00 am. Check-in gate is at Olson Drive and Russell Street.

******* There is an alcohol policy for the campgrounds next to Memory Lake in downtown Grantsburg. Campers will NOT be allowed to bring beer or wine coolers through the gates. Beer & wine coolers will be for sale by the case near the Memory Lake campground on Olson Drive. A free bag of ice will be given for each purchase.**

At the check in gate, Security personnel will be asking to search your vehicle and sleeping unit. If during the search, beer &/or wine coolers are found, it will need to be forfeited before entry. If you refuse the inspection, you will need to relocate to the Fairgrounds Campground or be turned away. No refunds will be given.

Campground 8 blocks away with free bus shuttle:

Fairgrounds (FG): 21 electric RV, motor home, camper sites (\$95) and 110 non-electric tent or RV, motor home, camper sites (\$65). A free bus shuttle runs about every 30 minutes from the event to the campground from early morning till after bar time. There is a family area with a quiet time at 10:00 pm; otherwise quiet time is at 1:00 a.m. Shower facilities are located in the fairgrounds building & porta-potties near by. Check-in gate is ¼ mile south of the stop light intersection of Highway 70 & Highway 48-87. The Fair board members sell a breakfast on Saturday and Sunday in the fair building.

*******Camping prices are based on the event, not a nightly fee.**

Camping Information

Campgrounds open: Thursday, July 15th at 10:00 am.

Campgrounds close: Monday, July 19th at 10:00 am.

*******Early arrivals will NOT be allowed! You will be asked to leave and not return until Thursday at 10:00 am.*******

At the check-in gate:

1. Show camping confirmation receipt to the attendant.

2. Only one vehicle will be issued a permit and allowed at your campsite. Display the permit on your vehicle's mirror. Additional vehicles must be parked on the streets or at the Fairgrounds. RV's and motor homes are considered a vehicle and a sleeping unit; no additional vehicles will be allowed.

3. Only one sleeping unit per campsite.

4. All campers need to purchase a 3 -day wristband at the gate and securely attach it to their wrist.

The 3-day wristband covers all days of racing and admission to Friday and Saturday night street dances.

Adult 3-day pass (ages 16 and over) \$20

Youth 3-day pass or One day (ages 10-15).....\$12

5. At ML, PS, & R check-in gates: camper's vehicles and sleeping units will be subject to an inspection by security personnel. Any beer &/or wine coolers that are found will be confiscated. If a camper refuses inspection/confiscation of beer &/or wine coolers or if security personnel determines it necessary, the camper will need to camp in the Fairgrounds campground. No refunds will be given. You will be allowed to have your beer and/or wine coolers at the Fairgrounds campsites. Budweiser, Michelob, and Miller beverages and Jack Daniels wine coolers, will be sold by the case from the refrigerated trucks by the Memory Lake campground. Free campsite delivery will be available for large purchases.

Camping Rules

1. Clean your camping area and place all garbage in trash containers.

2. Drive slowly through the campgrounds and keep **vehicle movement to a minimum.**

3. All campgrounds will be monitored by security and police-patrolled.

4. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

5. No pets in the campgrounds or the spectator areas.

6. No fireworks, firearms, assault items, bicycles, scooters, ATV's or remote-controlled toys.

7. No loud music at campsites or in the spectator areas. Security has the right to remove any item that they deem offensive.

8. No umbrellas or sun shelters. There are no refunds in case of inclement weather.

9. ID's will be checked & underage drinking of beer/alcohol will be enforced by the Police.

10. Security has the right to evict anyone who does not comply with the rules.

11. Fairgrounds campers: carry-on coolers with beer/alcohol/soda are not allowed in the spectator event area. Coolers with ice or freezer packs may be brought to the spectator event area. Formula/milk for infants or young children will be allowed.

Campfires

No firewood from across state lines.

Campfires are only allowed in an elevated campfire ring with an enclosed bottom.

\$20.00 sod-replacement fee will be charged if an elevated enclosed bottom campfire ring is not used.

All campfires will be subject to weather conditions and the WI DNR approval.

Campfire wood: \$3.00 per bundle or \$5.00 for 2 bundles.

Rented campfire rings: \$10.00 for the weekend rental. You don't even have to clean it—just leave it.
